Walter Reed Nursing & Rehabilitation Center is a 180-bed facility located in Gloucester. It has semi-private and private accommodations, including 51 beds dedicated to Memory Care. Our skilled team of RNs, LPNs and CNAs provide around-the-clock care to help individuals live their best life. We offer skilled nursing and long-term care, respite care and in-house rehabilitation services. The individual and their physician will determine what is the best fit.

Walter Reed Nursing & Rehabilitation Center is the only facility in Virginia Health Services to offer Memory Care. Individuals in the Memory Care units will find quiet, calming spaces that are sheltered in two secure units dedicated to our memory-impaired Residents. Each unit has its own dining area, activities room, relaxation area and Snoezelen Room, which is a multi-sensory environment.

From the start, our Residents and their families meet with our team members to establish a plan of care. A Resident Navigator will help introduce individuals and their loved ones to the facility and ease the transition process.

The interdisciplinary care plan team includes our nursing staff, social workers, recreational professionals, therapists and dietitians. The individuals in our care know from the time they arrive, they will be helped in living their best life.

A team of physical, occupational and speech therapists from VHS Rehabilitation will work with individuals to recover from injury or help with daily life skills.

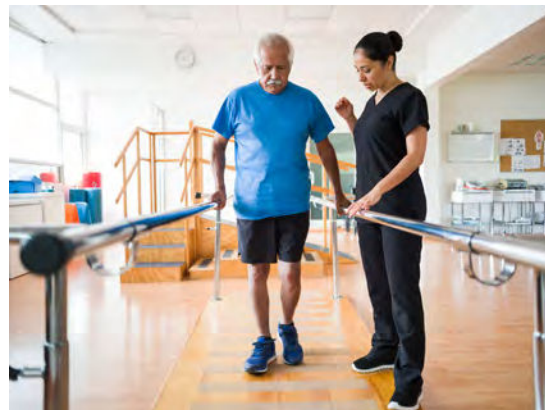
Individuals seeking skilled care need post-acute care, and are often shorter-term stays. Those in skilled care often need physician-prescribed physical, speech and/or occupational therapy to recover from significant surgery, or a stroke, respiratory, heart or kidney issues, and need additional care after being discharged from a hospital. Individuals also may require wound care, injection therapies, monitoring of vital signs and medical equipment that can't be found in a home.

When care needs become too much to go home, our long-term care provides a safe environment. Residents in long-term care need daily help with toileting, dressing, bathing, eating and have ambulatory and other health issues that require constant care and supervision.

If an individual needs a brief recovery period following an illness, accident, surgery or other medical problem, Virginia Health Services offers respite – or short-term nursing – care. We also offer respite care for individuals whose families need additional care giving support during emergencies or vacations.

Memory Care is a special secured unit to protect memory-impaired Residents, such as individuals with dementia and Alzheimer's disease, from wandering unsafely. More individualized care can be provided, with lower patient-to-staff ratios, and there are spaces specifically for Memory Care unit patients, including dining areas and relaxation and activities rooms.
