Dear Residents, Families, and Friends:

Visitation remains open at all of our facilities, and the rates of COVID in the community continue at a high level requiring all visitors to wear masks while visiting in the facility.

Following are the current visitation guidelines:

- Visitors need to complete the screening log to ensure you are not having COVID symptoms.
- Visitation is open, and in-person visits no longer require an appointment. Visits by Zoom can be scheduled on our website [www.vahs.com](http://www.vahs.com).
- You are able to visit regardless of the COVID status of the Resident.
- Mask wearing, and in some cases visitor testing, are based on community rates of COVID being substantial or high.
- Wearing a mask is required in the following situations:
  - Regardless of vaccination status, if there are active cases of COVID in the facility
  - If you are not fully vaccinated
  - When vaccine status is not disclosed, disclosure is your choice and not required
  - Regardless of vaccination status, wearing a mask and physical distancing in hallways, around other Residents, and in conversations with staff.

The table below summarizes the current community rate of COVID infections, and the masking requirements.
