Dear Residents, Families, and Friends:

Since the regulations regarding visitation, vaccines and masking have changed as of May 11, 2023, this will be the last weekly letter related to COVID. Following are the most notable changes due to the public health emergency expiring.

Masking is no longer required for COVID related issues such as community positivity rates and cases in the facility. You will be seeing the smiling faces of our team regularly now, and if the need arises due to COVID or other issues we may institute masking requirements again, however that should be infrequent and we will be sure to communicate that need in the future.

We will no longer be sending weekly letters, or the text messages and phone messages when there is a single case of COVID in the facility. Again, should there be larger issues with COVID or any other issues we will continue to use the notification technology, so please ensure we have your updated contact information.

Lastly, we will continue to use the iPads at the front entrances for visitor registration. We have shortened the form significantly and will most likely modify it again to shorten the process when visiting.

I cannot thank you enough for your patience and understanding over the last three years. There were frequent changes, all in the spirit of being cautious and safe, and I am happy that we are returning to more normal practices for visitation and overall lifestyle for our residents.
